

Regulatory challenges to maintain India's status of "Pharmacy of the World"

According to a study, the Indian generic drugs market stood at USD 24.53 billion in 2022. Indian government bodies and other regulatory agencies have pushed manufacturers to launch effective generic drug products to support and maintain the growth of Pharma market. However, poor quality products have been big challenge in the country. Central Drug Standard Control Organization (CDSCO), in 2018, identified approximately 4.5 substandard generic products of all generic drugs circulated in the Indian market. In the USA, stringent quality control procedures are in place which facilitates periodic quality check procedure. On the other hand, India has a different scenario altogether with widespread corruption making the task tedious. Moreover, the lack of fund, resources and manpower makes it worse to control the situation effectively. With as many as 64 US-FDA inspections in 2022 and 55 so far in 2023, the picture becomes clearer as to why Indian manufacturers are under scanner. Some common observations of these inspections include incompletely written procedures, issues with equipment cleaning procedure involved, untrained personnel, and insufficient control over laboratory procedures. Looking into seriousness of the situation, there is a need to address and overcome these issues. As per the principle of "survival of the Fittest', India will no longer be of the "Pharmacy of the world" if it maintains the status quo. Higher authorities and regulatory agencies need to consider the situation.

Workshop — Alumni Homecoming






